Completion of phase 2 - Capital Tower, Cardiff

Fullcircle are celebrating the completion of Phase 2 at Capital Tower, Greyfriars Road, Cardiff.

This prestigious £1 million plus refurbishment and fit-out contract continues with 11 of 25 floors having been completed in the last 6 months - on time and in budget. The refurb has seen us brighten all communal areas within the building, and install some major energy saving devices which are already having a positive impact on both cash flow and the environment at Capital Tower.

All lights in communal areas and toilets have been changed to movement sensor lights and all taps are operated by infra-red, meaning they are only activated by the proximity of hands, having a positive impact in the reduction of instances of flooding and water usage.

Occupiers have also reported improved motivation and productivity from those staff working adjacent to the areas that have already been upgraded. Proof, if it were needed, that investments into staff welfare are always worth it.
